DESCRIPTION

Wayang Pacific Maple marine plywood is especially designed for boat construction. It is manufactured under strict quality control conditions to comply with the internationally recognised British Standard BS 1088. The adhesive used is a special marine grade phenol formaldehyde resin that complies with BS 1203. Both faces of the sheets are sanded to A grade quality.

TIMBER

Timber used is sustained growth timber from Indonesian forests, and is a selected cut from a variable group of timbers known as Shorea species. The term Pacific Maple is applied to this selected group of timbers.

PANEL SIZES

All plywood sheets are 2440 x 1220 mm (8 ft. x 4 ft)

THICKNESSES & PLYS

Wayang marine plywood is available in the following thicknesses and constructions, with approximate weights per sheet as follows:

4 mm	3 ply	6.0 — 6.5 kg
6mm	5ply	9.0—9.5
9mm	5ply	13.0—14.0
12 mm	7 ply	17.5 — 18.5
18 mm	7 ply	26.5 — 27.5
